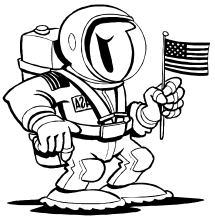

Later this year, a new treasure will be discovered at the White Plains Public Library. Our children's library will expand from 7,000 to 13,000 square feet and transform into *The Trove* – a magical place of imagination, exploration and discovery, thanks to a \$1 million fund-raising campaign by the White Plains Library Foundation and a \$2 million capital project from The City of White Plains.

With \$280,000 still to be raised by the end of June, the Foundation is grateful to over 500 generous Library Foundation Board and Steering Committee members, corporations, local business and individuals who have given \$720,000 to date.

To kick off the final months of "Imagine, Explore, Discover The Trove - The Campaign for the Children's Library," a free family event will take place at the White Plains Performing Arts Center on **Saturday, March 19th from 12:30 to 4:30 pm**. "The Trove Family Fun Day" will feature performances, crafts, food and surprises, and will highlight the many ways families can participate in making *The Trove* a reality.
